Church Pianist Job Description

Principal Function:

The church pianist is responsible to the Senior Pastor, Music Director and to the church for providing worship leadership from the piano for congregational services and for accompanying performing groups as assigned.

Responsibilities:

1. Meet regularly with the Music Director and/or other music group leaders as needed to coordinate worship planning.
2. Play for all regularly scheduled weekly worship services. This includes Sunday and any other planned services.
3. Plan and use appropriate repertoire for preludes, offertories, and postludes as needed or scheduled. A good selection of piano music should be maintained.
4. Rehearse each week with praise team and/or instrumental groups as assigned by the Music Director. Responsibilities in this area will be included but not limited to accompanying the Adult, Youth, and Children's Choir. Leadership as a director for a children's group can and will be substituted if available.
5. Rehearse with, and accompany vocalists as needed for the worship services.
6. Play for special services and meetings at the church when scheduled (revivals, conventions, special conferences, etc.).
7. Be available, as schedule permits, to play for weddings and/or possibly funerals, if needed. (Additional compensation through personal arrangements)
8. Allow adequate practice time each week for thorough preparation of rehearsal and service music.
